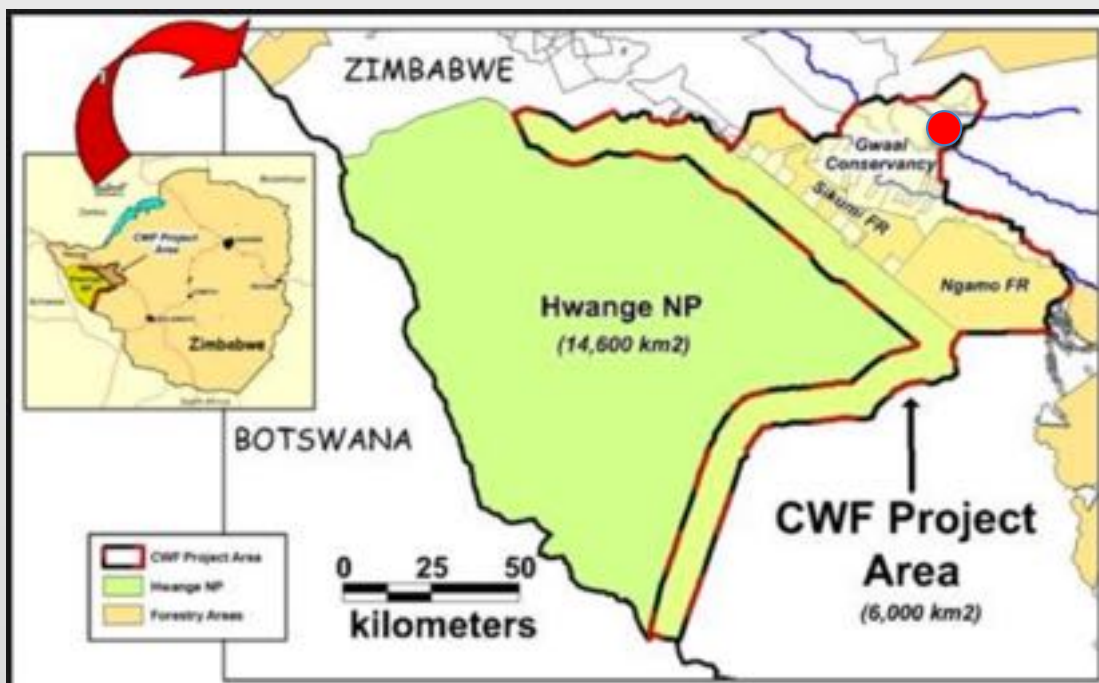
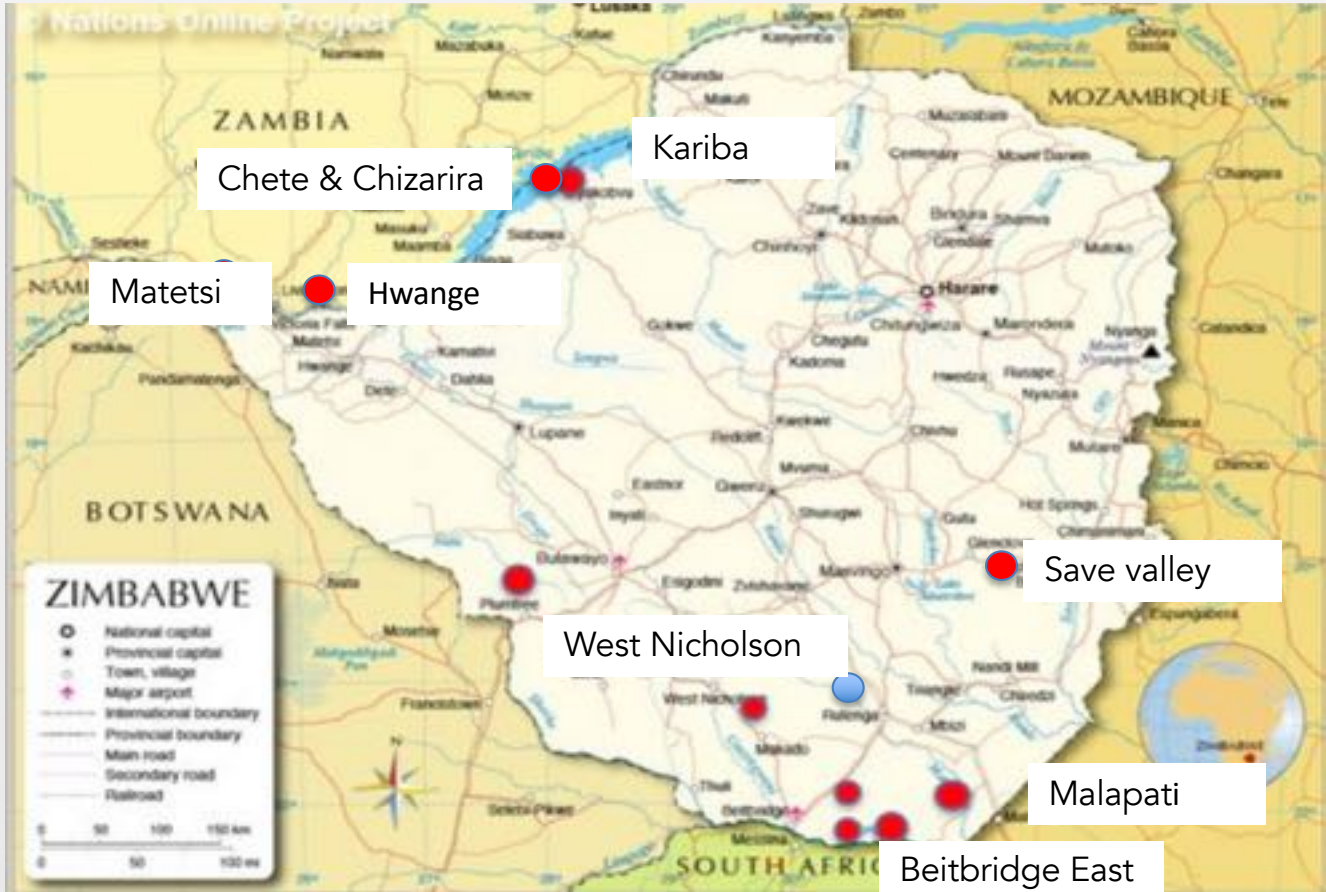

## ZAMBIA: GENERAL INFORMATION (A)

### HUNTING SEASON

The Zambian hunting season runs from the beginning of May to the end of November. This is mostly the dry season in Zambia. Temperatures vary during the dry season from mild to very hot and in June, July and August the Kafue experiences cool to cold mornings and evenings.

We do however consider June through to end of September to be our prime hunting months. Although October has good hunting, the temperatures can be very high and in November there is a chance of rain.

### HEALTH

An anti-malarial course should be taken three weeks prior to arrival in Zambia and terminated six weeks after your return. We suggest that you consult your doctor regarding the prophylactics required. Please ensure that we are informed before your arrival about any health or dietary needs. It is highly recommended that all clients have an international travel and health insurance which would include evacuation out of the safari area and Zambia should an emergency arise.

### FIREARMS

We recommend that all clients bring a minimum caliber of .375 or more for larger dangerous game (buffalo and Lion) and a 300 Win Mag. or similar caliber rifle for Leopard and plains game species. A good quality variable scope preferably with red dot illumination is recommended for rifles – especially where cats will be hunted in low light conditions.

Importation of ammunition into Zambia is regulated to 100 rounds per rifle and 200 rounds per shotgun. Please note that a non - refundable Excise Duty is payable on all ammunition being brought into Zambia at a rate of US \$4 per round.

Firearm import permits must be obtained before your arrival. It is imperative to ensure we are supplied well in advance of the correct make and serial numbers of the rifles you will be using. Errors on the firearm permit will lead to refusal of temporary import of firearms by the Zambian Authorities. The amount of ammunition stipulated on the permit may not be varied once the license is issued.

### BOOKINGS AND PAYMENTS

Deposit of 50% of booking estimate on date of booking and the full payment of your safari 90 days prior to your arrival date. Trophy fees and other miscellaneous expenses not included in your estimate will need to be settled on completion of your safari so that we can comply with the national parks authorities requirement that all monies are paid and essential paperwork lodged with them within 14 days of the completion of your safari, this ultimately circumvents any delays in the shipping of your trophies.

PLEASE NOTE: only US\$ cash is accepted for payments due at the conclusion of the hunt. Telegraphic transfers can be made prior to the start of the hunt to pre-pay trophy fees and extras. This will avoid traveling with large sums of cash.

Bank charges on all telegraphic transfer shall be for the clients' account. All charges quoted are subject to change.

Please note that travel days used for movement between hunting areas are counted as hunting days and that any client accommodation required in Lusaka during the safari will be for the client's account.

## ZAMBIA: GENERAL INFORMATION (B)

### LUANGA VALLEY AREAS

- Upper Lupande GMA is one of the prime Luangwa valley concession represented; this is a very large game management area that bounds both the South Luangwa and Nsefu national parks. Upper Lupande is a great area for hunting buffalo, lion, leopard, hippo, crocodile and a variety of plains game including Roan antelope.
- Late season hunts also offer opportunities for good size elephant trophies.
- We are also hunting some large fenced and unfenced private hunting blocks that offer excellent opportunities for most Luangwa species.
- Species available - Luangwa areas – Baboon, Buffalo, Bushbuck(Chobe), Bushpig, Crocodile, Duiker (Common), Elephant, Grysbok (Sharpes), Hartebeest (Lichtenstein), Hippo, Hyena, Impala, Kudu, Leopard, Lion, Puku, Roan, Warthog, Waterbuck(Common), Wildebeest (Cooksons), Zebra.

### KAFUE

- Namwala GMA is the primary concession represented in the Kafue region. This area has a large boundary with the Kafue National Park and Mumbwa West GMA, and is especially known for its great lion, leopard and sable hunting. Namwala also has an abundant hippo and crocodile population and offers excellent opportunities for hunting a variety of high trophy quality plains game species. Park along the Kafue River. It is a large concession, approximately 250 000 acres of hunting area. Namwala is famous for its huge leopard and sable. There is also a healthy population of buffalo and lion are resident in good numbers. # CAMEROON: GENERAL INFORMATION

Our Cameroon partner and professional hunter has more than 30 years experience of Central Africa hunting and is also the President of the French Professional Hunters Association ACP.

## Hunting in Cameroon can be divided into 2 basic areas:

- 1) The RAIN FOREST SOUTH-EAST CAMEROON BORDER and CAR. - May, June, July
- 2) The CAMEROON SAVANNAH- January, February, March, April

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Day fees for both areas for 12 to 13 day hunt are € 42000 (1 Hunter, 1 PH) with accommodation in Main Camp, or € 29000 (1 Hunter, 1 PH) with accommodation in fly camp

The hunter can bring up to 2 Guns in Cameroon. The Gun permit and visa are applied in the country of origin at the local Cameroon Embassy or through the booking agent.

It is highly recommended to check enough time in advance that the number in the gun permit is the same as the one of the gun.

Bring the exact number of ammo that is allowed on your gun permit. Also make sure the rifle is sighted with the same ammo that you will be used during your hunt.

We will assist you with the domestic flight arrangements from Yaounde /Douala to Garoua, hotel if needed in Yaounde/Douala, meet and greet, transfer to hotel and custom assistance in Yaounde /Douala if overnight is necessary, (do not save on this assistance).

Meet and greet in Garoua is included.

The hunting permit is obtained by the outfitter.

90 Days prior to your hunt, you will be requested to send the following docs to your outfitter:

- Copy of passport
- 4 identity photos
- copy of the visa
- copy of the gun permit (6 copies on landing)
- medical prescription saying : the hunter is able to hunt in Cameroon.

## PLEASE NOTE:

- Yellow Fever vaccine is mandatory to present on arrival to Cameroon
- Malarone treatment or equivalent is highly recommended.
- Make sure to have liability insurance and repatriation with you. You may be asked to show it.
- Let the outfitter know in advance if you have medical restriction or food or beverages preferences
- Make sure to have enough EURO cash on you and not US dollar for gratuities and trophy fees unpaid upfront.

Local staff and people from villages are happy to receive old clothes from hunters, so think about bringing some if possible. Use Dark green clothes, not light. Also shoes to protect ankle and strong soles are recommended. Your feet are the key to your safari

There is laundry in camp. Your clothes are returned clean in 24 hours, you should not need more than 3 sets.

The generator 220 volts works from 6pm to 10pm, sometimes at nap time for air condition. You need all your personal medication, pharmacy, sun creams, eyeglasses binoculars, small torch, and any personal belongings you may use.

## Climate in the Cameroon Savannah

The climate in the Cameroon Savannah is generally warm. Average temperatures range from 90f to 110f. Mornings in the early season can be cool often dropping into the 50f. By mid morning, the temperature has warmed up considerably.

Notes: Some species requires driving to other concessions. Prices are subject to change without notice.

## Safari Costs Include:

- Meet and Greet Kika (Forest) and Garoua or Ngoundere (Savannah)
- Transfer to hunting areas from Kika (Forest Hunt) and Garoua or Ngoundere (Savannah Hunt)
- Full Board , staff and Laundry, House wine and drinks in camp in moderation and camp water which is clean , safe and good tasting.
- PH and trackers, The use of additional fly camps and equipment,
- Vehicles during the safari
- The dip and pack includes ( Certificate of origin, veterinary certificate, CITES papers for export, customs clearing expenses by freight

## Safari Cost Exclude:

- Hunting Permit fees
- Airfare to and from Kika and Garoua or Ngoundere
- Additional transfers outside of hunting areas. (Savannah -300 Euro and Rain Forest on request)
- Meet and Greet, custom clearance in Doula or Yaounde, hotel, transfers and expenses out of camp.
- Personal Expenses and Tips.
- Trip insurance for cancellation and travel. (including repatriation for health reasons, rifles and luggage)
- Trophy fees not included in the estimate and community /village tax.
- Dip and pack and shipment to Paris under customs
- Savannah mineral water at 3.5 euro per bottle, and wine off wine list
- Charter flights
- Gratuities, cigarettes.
- Air charter and commercial flights
- Firearm rentals available on request in the event you don't bring your own rifle.
- Taxidermy work and shipping of trophies.

## OTHER IMPORTANT NOTES:

- In event of Elephant hunt where permitted, an authorization of country of origin to import tusks is required by Cameroon administration to deliver hunting permit.
- No refund on cancellations. Late payments will result in cancellation unless agreed with Outfitter.
- Client to be refunded if outfitter cancels the hunt for any reason, including government closing hunting.
- Outfitter cannot be held responsible for change of government regulations, before, during or after the safari or for violation in the country of origin of the client.
- Outfitter will not be responsible for damages of trophies caused to trophies during shipping or handling by brokers to final destination . The outfitter however will put in his best effort and good faith to ensure best service.
- Approximately 6 months prior to your Safari, we will require the following from you:
- Copy of Valid Passport
- 4 ID Photos and Copy of the purchase invoice of rifles client intend to bring on safari.
- Client Liability insurance that are valid in Cameroon and other Insurances need to be taken out.
- Visa and Temporary permit for importation of firearms into Cameroon.
- Client must make sure the number of registration number of firearm on permit is the same as on rifle.
- **Warning Note:** It is Clients' responsibility to take out trip insurance and trip cancellation insurance as well as any other insurance needed, including repatriation for health reasons, rifles and luggage). No refunds on payments made will be given except in the event outfitter cancellation for whatever reason.

### Example of pack list

- 2 pairs of good walking boots or running shoes (run in). Ground can be uneven so cushioning and ankle support is recommended.
- 1 pair of sandals or lightweight shoes for the evening around the camp.
- 4 pairs of good socks
- 3 pairs of long hunting pants (Dark Khaki or Olive Green)
- 3 pairs of short hunting pants (if you are accustomed to shorts)
- 3 hunting shirts (Dark Khaki or Olive Green)
- 1 hunting Jacket - Real-tree type camouflage, Dark Khaki or Olive Green
- 1 warm sweater or jumper
- 1 light weight waterproof rain jacket
- Sunscreen, Cap or Hat
- Casual wear for evenings
- Personal Camera Equipment, Binoculars, Insect repellent
- Malaria prophylaxis - as per your Doctors advice
- Skin so soft by Avon (for Tsetse fly's)

### Note:

Military type camouflage is not permitted in most African countries, but Real-tree types are normally accepted. Laundry is done each day except for the days when you change camp and the day of departure.
